### **FROM THE PRINCIPAL . . .** God's Name is Holy

### ACADEMIC ADVISING CONTINUED... 2017-2018 MLHS Re-Enrollment

All current students who will be returning to Milwaukee Lutheran High School in the fall for the 2017-2018 school year must re-enroll in Skyward. Over 300 families have completed this process. By verifying your student's information in Skyward, you are declaring your intent to return to Milwaukee Lutheran High School. To re-enroll in Skyward, follow the steps below:

- 1. Login to Skyward FAMILY Access (available under "Quick Links" at the top of <u>www.milwaukeelutheran.org</u>)
- 2. Click 2017-2018 MLHS RE-ENROLLMENT
- 3. Complete Steps 1a-1e to review & update student/family information
- 4. Click "Submit" to complete the re-enrollment process

Additionally, Tuition and Choice families must complete the following information:

- <u>Tuition Families</u>: Current tuition agreements in TADS for the 2016-2017 school year will automatically roll over in May for 2017-2018 school year. Contact Elizabeth in the Business Office at 414-421-9100 ext. 215 with any questions.
- <u>Milwaukee Parental Choice Program Families</u> (MPCP): Re-apply for your CHOICE seat for the 2017-2018 school year.
- <u>Wisconsin Parental Choice Program Families</u> (WPCP): Re-apply for your CHOICE seat for the 2017-2018 school year.



You just need to click on it and the statement will generate.
