The year may be winding down, but our editors are still hard at work to deliver concise, timely, and trustworthy drug therapy and medication management recommendations via our Letters.


Last month we took a look at transitions of care for patients on immunotherapies, and in December, we'll provide guidance and strategies for opioid stewardship.
