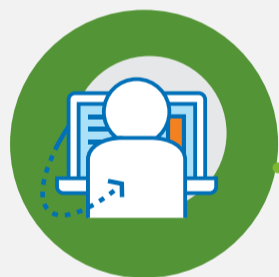
Client Deployment

Licensing

Make sure to review licensing details, many have very specific terms.



Migration Plan

Infrastructure Reliability

In the cloud, redundancy happens at the application layer. This means additional steps may need to be taken to ensure you have an SLA.
