At School

- Discuss the school's acceptable use policy

- Communicate with parents & teachers about technology use outside of class

At Home

- Keep computers in highly visible areas or rooms
- Create an acceptable use policy at home that supports school policy
- Encourage device safety for passwords & sharing personal info
- Set limits for how much time is spent on devices
- Be alert to signs of unhealthy online relationships or predators
