



Academic Intervention Specialist

OnePurpose School (OP) is a TK-5th grade school in San Francisco's Bayview neighborhood. OP is a free, open-enrollment, college-preparatory, public charter school. OP's model brings together four major educational advances in service of our students: project-based learning, STEM, personalization of curriculum and a keen focus on fostering student agency.

Who We Are Looking For

The role of the Intervention Specialist is to provide intensive academic instruction to students both in their classroom settings and in the learning lab. Additionally, the Intervention Specialist coordinates services at the school site and supports colleagues in including students successfully in diverse settings by providing teacher coaching, modeling and development opportunities. The Intervention Specialist works collaboratively with classroom teachers, school leadership and the COST implementation team to maintain the academic, social and emotional needs of each student.

Job Duties:

- Work effectively as a member of a multidisciplinary team to implement academic, behavioral, and therapeutic services for students in need of intervention
- Provide coaching and professional development to support school staff in experiencing success with all students
- Implement research-based interventions aligned with the three tiers of the RTI pyramid, including specialized academic instruction per students IEPs
- Provide an individualized academic intervention program to target diverse learners' needs
- Employ authentic and norm-referenced assessment strategies to monitor progress and guide instructional planning and decision making
- Chair IEP meetings and, if asked, the school's Coordination of Services Team meetings
- Engage caregivers in the educational process, providing frequent opportunities to discuss student growth and needs
- Participate in professional learning communities to enhance practice and create coherence
- Maintain a high standard of professional behavior at all times
- Perform all other duties as necessary for the good of the agency as instructed by supervisor
