Flu Vaccination 2019



Quadrivalent Flu Vaccine (strains)

- A/Brisbane/02/2018 (H1N1)pdm09-like virus
- A/Kansas/14/2017 (H3N2)-like virus
- B/Colorado/06/2017 (Victoria/2/87 lineage)
- B/Phuket/3073/2013 (Yamagata/16/88 lineage)

Dosage

Age	Dose (vaccine IM)	# doses
6 months to 8 years old	0.5 ml	1 or 2*
9 years old and +	0.5 ml	1
Adults	0.5 ml	1

*Children who are < 9 years old who have never received the seasonal flu vaccine should receive 2 doses 4 weeks apart. The second dose is not required if at least 1 dose of seasonal flu vaccine was given in the past.

Contraindications

- History of Guillain-Barré syndrome within 6 weeks after receiving a vaccine• Individuals who have experienced oculorespiratory syndrome (ORS) with lower respiratory tract symptoms (such as difficulty breathing, wheezing, thoracic oppression) must receive the vaccine only after evaluation of the risks and benefits for them of the vaccine.
- Previous anaphylactic reaction to a flu vaccine or to another vaccine of the same components.
