

A PRACTICAL TOUR OF VISION:

Use the checklist to practice navigating the features of Vision for Chromebooks

RESOURCES

What do you need for this training?

- Teacher device with Netop Vision Teacher Application
- Chromebooks with Netop Vision Student Application and Extension installed on user profile* (2-4)

**Student users should be other teachers for the purposes of this training. Use test accounts or download the student application and extension to the teacher's profile.*

PREPARATION

Roster your practice classes!

- Participants form groups of 3-4
- 1 Participant is the TEACHER, and makes a Google Classroom (ie: "Training")
- 2-3 participants are STUDENTS, and join the Google Classroom

TASKS

TASK 1: START THE CLASS / DRAW ATTENTION

TEACHER Sign in to Vision Teacher Application  Select the training classroom. Start class  from tool bar.

STUDENTS Sign in to device only. Grant permission to share your screen.

TEACHER Click draw attention  so you have the students' focus for instructions. (Release by clicking again)

TASK 2: DEMO MODE

TEACHER Select demo  from the tool bar. Minimize the application. Go to www.desmos.com in your browser. Click "Start Calculating."

STUDENTS Try to use your device. What happens?

TASK 3: SEND A MESSAGE

TEACHER Send a message  "Keep up the great work-5 minutes!"

STUDENTS Accept the message.

(1) **STUDENT** Open an off-topic website / game.

TEACHER Send a message  JUST to the off-topic student. (hint: select the student FIRST)

TASK 4: PUSH A LINK / LIMIT BROWSING

TEACHER Push a link  readwritethink.org

STUDENTS Navigate away from this website. What happens?

TEACHER Apply the "on-the-fly" web filter (hint:  → Configure Filter Web... → )

STUDENTS Navigate to a new website. What happens now?

TEACHER While lock is engaged, push a link  newsela.com

STUDENTS Navigate to a new website. What happens now? (hint: )

NOTES

☐ BONUS: VISION PORTAL AND CUSTOM WEB FILTERS

TEACHER Go to  then  Log in to Netop Vision Portal: 

TEACHER Add a new filter web list  Name the list and add a few links of your choice.

TEACHER Select  You should see your new list here.

TEACHER Return to the Vision Teacher Application  Apply the custom filter (hint:  →  → )

STUDENTS Try to navigate the internet. Click  to reveal the links.

FEATURES SUMMARY:

Keep this as a reference guide for each of our features

		On the Teacher Device 	On the Student Device(s) 
	Live View	See live thumbnails of all students. Click on a student for a larger view.	“Accept” the request to view (once per class).
	Demo	Anything on your screen will be shared.	Full screen view of your presentation or demonstration. Their device is locked.
	Message	Write out a message to your student / students and hit send.	Message appears in the middle of their screen.
	Push a Link	Type or paste the link in the window that populates and hit send.	A new browser tab appears with the website you selected. (Will not close their active browsing session.)
	Blank Screen	A teacher favorite, this is your pause button.	Entire device becomes disabled with a friendly message asking for attention.
	Limit Browsing	Apply a filter to limit students browsing. Create a custom list in the Portal →  Lock on the fly → 	Internet restricted to the permitted websites – browser message populates with allowable links.
	Home	Navigate back to your Google Classroom list and end your session	Devices continue to work, but you cannot interact with them.
