

PRIVACY STATEMENT VIDEO SURVEILLANCE

A. Identity and address of the person responsible

Sim Tech Holdings, LLC.(hereinafter and interchangeably **HOLDER** or the Responsible), with address at 5705 Timber Star, San Antonio Texas, 78250; expressly informs you:

B. Personal data collected and processed

To fulfill the purposes indicated in this Privacy Statement, we collect the following categories of personal data:

1. Image.

The personal data whose categories have been identified may be collected by the Controller through the video surveillance system at the Controller's facilities and/or at facilities other than the main offices, where the Controller's staff work and where users of the Controller work. the services offered by the Responsible, have access.

The acceptance of this Privacy Statement entails the authorization of the use of image and voice data in the facilities of the Responsible.

C. sensitive personal data

For the purposes described in the following section, HOLDER does not collect sensitive personal data.

D. Purposes of the treatment

a) Original and necessary purposes:

1. Security of employees, visitors, customers, supplier personnel and other people who have access to HOLDER facilities.
2. Control and registration of access to HOLDER facilities.

b) Additional purposes:

They do not exist.

E. Transfers of personal data

HOLDER does not transfer personal data for the fulfillment of the purposes described in this Privacy Statement.

Your personal data will not be transferred to third parties without your consent, and in any case complying with the conditions provided by the corresponding law.

F. Exercise of data protection rights.

In all legally appropriate cases, you may at any time exercise your rights of access, rectification, cancellation and opposition through the procedures that we have implemented for such purposes.

The corresponding request must comply with the requirements established in current legislation, by writing to our Personal Data Department, at the address indicated at the beginning of this Statement.

The request must contain and accompany the following:

1. Your name and address or other means to communicate the response to your request.
2. Documents proving your identity or, where appropriate, legal representation.

3. The clear and precise description of the Rights that you wish to exercise; and
4. Any other element or document that facilitates the location of personal data.

Within a maximum period of twenty business days, counted from the date on which the corresponding request is received, we will notify you of the decision adopted. If the request is appropriate, it will be made effective within fifteen business days following the date on which we communicate the response. In the event that the information provided in your request is erroneous or insufficient, or the necessary documents are not attached to prove your identity or the corresponding legal representation, the Responsible party, within five business days following the receipt of your request, will require the rectification of the deficiencies to be able to process it. In these cases, you will have ten business days to meet the rectification requirement.

Alternatively, you may direct your request to our Personal Data Department through the email address: support@simdatagroup.com, complying with all the previously listed requirements, establishing as the subject of the communication "Data protection rights" and/or revocation of consent". The deadlines for the procedure will be the same as those mentioned in this section. The use of electronic means to exercise the aforementioned rights authorizes the Responsible to respond to the corresponding request through the same means, unless the owner himself indicates another means, clearly and expressly.

You may obtain the information or personal data requested through simple copies, electronic documents in conventional formats (Word, PDF, etc.), or through any other legitimate means that guarantees and proves the effective exercise of the requested right.

You will be responsible for keeping your personal data in possession of the Responsible updated. Therefore, you guarantee and are responsible, in any case, for the veracity, accuracy, validity and authenticity of the personal data provided, and undertake to keep them duly updated, communicating any changes to the Responsible Party.

G. Withdrawal of consent

You may revoke your consent for the processing of your personal data, without retroactive effect, in all those cases in which said revocation does not imply the impossibility of fulfilling obligations derived from a legal relationship in force between you and the Controller or implies a breach of general provisions of public order that establish the obligation to maintain the processing of your personal data for a certain period of time.

The procedure for the revocation of consent, if applicable, will be the same as that established in the immediately preceding section for the exercise of your rights.

H. Limitations on the use and disclosure of your personal data

You may limit the use or disclosure of your personal data by directing the corresponding request to our Personal Data Department. The requirements to prove your identity, as well as the procedure to meet your request will be the same as those indicated in the section "Exercise of data protection rights".

The Controller has means and procedures to ensure the inclusion of some of your data in their own exclusion lists, when you expressly request their inclusion in them. The Responsible will grant the registered holders the corresponding registration certificate.

I. Automatic means to collect personal data

On our website we use files known as "cookies" to facilitate navigation and communication through it. If you visit our website and/or send information through it, the cookies we use will allow us to collect, analyze and store technical information related to your browsing habits and the use of said communication channels. Cookies allow this information to be collected automatically, at the very moment the user makes use of our electronic services.

You can disable the installation of cookies in your internet browser. Changes to this Privacy Statement may also be communicated by email, when said medium has been established as a communication channel between the Owner and the Responsible Party, during the validity of any legal relationship.
