# **Rebate Checklist**

Get your rebate check faster by checking off these easy steps before mailing your application form. Incomplete applications may be delayed.

- □ Completely fill out application with CPS Energy Account information (name that appears on CPS Energy bill) associated with the installation address.
- Attach all receipts and/or invoices (itemized cost breakdown).
- □ All applicable invoices with required model/serial numbers and matching AHRI certificate (HVAC rebate).
- □ Replaced equipment information must be filled out & pictures of replaced equipment must be provided if applying for an early replacement rebate (HVAC rebate).
- □ Review Terms and Conditions, sign and date application
- □ Make and retain copies of all documents and applications.
- □ Contractor portion must be completely filled out (not required for self- installed insulation).
- Send all documents to correct address and/or email address listed on application (sending application to any other address or email will delay your rebate).

#### Important

A final itemized invoice for all materials, labor and taxes related to the Rebate Application must be attached. All equipment must be new. No reconditioned or used equipment would qualify for rebates. Proposals are not considered confirmation of purchase and install and are not accepted.

#### Verification

The sales receipt indicating date of purchase, dealer/contractor name, manufacturer name and model number of equipment must accompany the rebate application. Incomplete applications will be delayed. CPS Energy reserves the right to verify sales receipts and installations.

# **Terms and Conditions**

### **General Eligibility**

- 1. Applicant must be a current Texas residential electric customer of CPS Energy.
- 2. For insulation measures, home must be at least 5 years old.
- 3 Purchase and installation must be completed between June 1, 2019 and January 31, 2020. Application must be received within 30 days of equipment or insulation install date.
- 4. Rebates are available for equipment and insulation installed in heated or conditioned living spaces only. Equipment or insulation installed in garages or shops are not eligible for rebates.
- 5. Applications will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis. The program will end when the budget is depleted. Funds are limited.
- To avoid delay, the contractor invoice returned with your rebate application must include manufacturer, model and serial numbers, efficiency rating and date of installation. Equipment cost, labor and tax must be itemized. Labor charges for selfinstalled jobs are not eligible for rebates.
- 7. Where applicable, energy efficiency ratings must comply with those listed in the Air Conditioning Heating and Refrigeration Institute (AHRI) directory found at www.ahridirectory.org. All space heating equipment needs to bear the AHRI certified mark. All pool pumps must be listed as ENERGY STAR<sup>®</sup> qualified equipment.
- 8. To qualify for early replacement, photos and replaced equipment information is mandatory. Replaced equipment MUST be less than 25 years old and operational to qualify. If any information is not provided, the system is 25 years or older, and/or not operational then rebate will be processed as a replacement on burnout rebate.
- Once all required documentation is received, please allow 8-12 weeks for processing of the rebate (processing time subject to change based on volume of rebates received). Rebates processed in order received.

**REBATE SPECIFICATIONS:** Attic insulation must be installed between conditioned (air conditioned living area bel ow ceiling) and unconditioned areas (attic) to qualify. Square footage measurements will be verified against Bexar County property tax records,or inspected by a CPS Energy inspector. *For attics with more than 24 inches of attic clearance:* final insulation must be at least R-3 8 and existing attic insulation must be no greater than R-14 . For attics with less than 24 inches of attic clearance: the final insulation level must be at least R-19, existing attic insulation for low ceilings must be no greater than R-11 . Degradation due to age and density of the existing insulation should be taken into account. All insulation must be new materials and have R-Value stated on the packaging material. Garages and other non-living areas do not qualify. \*Please note: Rebates are not able to be processed for gas heated homes with no air conditioning.

**REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION:** Applications must be signed by the Account Holder. Provide an itemized and dated purchase receipt or sales invoice (include existing R-value and ending R-value, type and square feet) along with your application form. *\*If the existing insulation is less than R-5 then the following documentation is required:* one photo showing the entire attic floor and one close-up photo of a ruler that shows the measurement of the depth of the insulation.

**REBATE SPECIFICATIONS:** Horse power rating is based on rated horse power listed on ENERGY STAR<sup>®</sup> website. Motor only replacement does not qualify for this rebate. Rebuilding an existing pool pump does not qualify for this rebate. Must be a NEW (not used) unit that is listed on the ENERGY STAR website as a variable speed pool pump and carry a minimum one-year manufacturer warranty. Must be a one for one replacement. Must be installed by a licensed plumber and be compliant with all local, state and national codes regarding the installation and operation of water heating equipment. Must be programmed to the energy efficiency standards required by ENERGY STAR. Pool pumps for newly constructed pools do not qualify.

**REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION:** Applications must be signed and complete. The contractor's invoice must show the model number and serial number of all equipment installed along with cost of equipment and installation.
