

The following steps that I have included below should allow you to move StorLogix from the existing computer that it resides on, to your new computer:

1. Create a Restore Point in StorLogix on the old computer by going to File>Create Restore Point. Please note that this function is only available in version of StorLogix 3.x or greater. If you are running on version 2.x, you will be required to create standard backup files by going to File>Backup. Create or copy the Restore Point or backup files to a form of removable media such as a USB thumb drive or an external hard drive.

2. Install version StorLogix on your new computer.

*NOTE: If your new computer is Windows 8 or 10, you will need to purchase a 5.X version of the software. You can obtain this by calling Sales at 1-800-523-9504.*

3. Once StorLogix has been installed on your new computer, you can restore your data by going to Start>Programs>PTI Integrated Systems>StorLogix>Restore Site Data. You will then be prompted if you are using a Restore Point or a SQL database backup. In the dialogue box that appears after that, you will be required to select the correct SQL instance, normally (local)\PTI, then browse for the file you will be restoring.

4. Upon restoring any valid backups or Restore Point, you can then launch StorLogix and perform an additional configuration of Management Interface and LogixServer.
