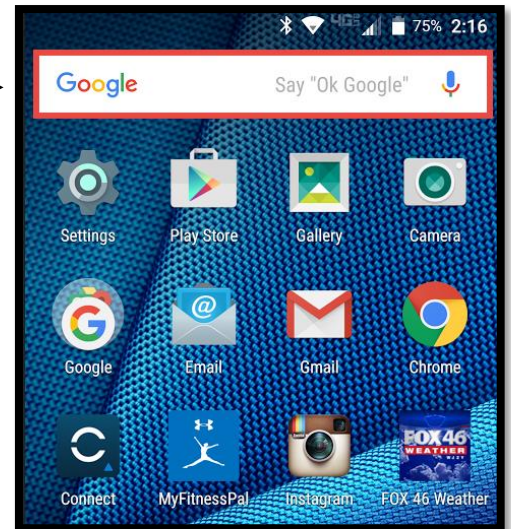


GOOGLE NOW COMMANDS



One feature of Google Now is a voice activated assistant tool. Simply speak commands to your phone and watch Google Now work its magic.

1. To launch Google Now, tap the **microphone** icon, or simply say, "OK, Google."



COMMON COMMANDS:

- "Search for Google Doodles"
- "Meaning of Android"
- "Synonyms of visages"
- "Show stocks for Samsung electronics"
- "How old is Larry Page?"
- "What is the population of Bangladesh?"
- "Who is the CEO of Samsung?"
- "How tall is Kobe Bryant?"

TIME & DATE COMMANDS

- "When is father's day in 2018?"
- "Show me the time and date"
- "When does sun set in Charlotte?"
- "What time is it in Sydney?"

WEATHER COMMANDS:

- "Is it raining in New York?"
- "Will it snow today"
- "What's the weather in Columbus, OH?"
- "Is it raining outside?"
- "Is there any rain expected for Friday?"
- "What is the weather forecast for Wednesday?"

MAPS & NAVIGATION COMMANDS:

“Where is the statue of liberty situated?”
“Show all hotels near me”
“Bookstores in New York”
“Take me to the convention center on foot”
“Coffee bars in Madrid”
“How far is the motorway from my current location?”
“When does the next train arrive?”

CALCULATIONS & CONVERSIONS COMMANDS:

“How much is 57 point 78 minus 22”
“65 plus 135 into 20 minus 18 equals”
“Convert 36 degrees Celsius into Fahrenheit”
“How many gallons in 1 kiloliter”
“Convert 100 hours into minutes”
“What is the 75 percent of 1 point 5 million”
