
There are many services available that allow you stream movies and television shows. This document compares Netflix to Hulu to Amazon Instant Video.

NETFLIX:

- Cost: \$8 - \$12 a month
- Originally Movie oriented (DVD Service)
- Now TV show-oriented
- HUGE library of Original content
- Can download shows to watch offline

Best Bet: If you are looking for the widest selection of movies and tv shows and/or Original content, Netflix is your best bet.



HULU:

- Cost: \$8 - \$12/month
- TV oriented service
- Next Day viewing its biggest draw
- Decent Movie Library
- Some Original content

Best Bet: If you are looking to cut the cable cord and still have access to Network TV shows, then Hulu is your best bet.



AMAZON PRIME INSTANT VIDEO:

- Cost: \$99/yr or \$11/month (comes as part of your Amazon Prime membership)
- Movie oriented service
- Limited TV Shows
- Some Original content
- Can download shows to watch offline

Best Bet: If you already have Amazon Prime, and don't care to take on any more monthly expenses, Amazon Prime Instant Video is your best bet.
