TALKING POINTS

NEED SOME HELP CRAFTING YOUR ANNOUNCEMENT OF HUNGER SUNDAY FROM THE STAGE? HERE ARE SOME TALKING POINTS THAT CAN HELP YOU TO BEST PREPARE:

THE POVERTY PROBLEM

- It's not okay that 18,000 children die everyday from hunger-related causes
- It's not okay that mother's don't have access to the medical supplies they need to keep their children healthy
- It's not okay that 12-year-old girls are forced into marriages because their families can't afford to care for them any longer
- It's not okay that disasters, wars and social injustices keep people from access to clean water
- It's not okay for us to do nothing

THE CHURCH'S RESPONSIBILITY TO BE A PART OF THE SOLUTION

- **Matthew 28:19:**
Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.
- **Matthew 25:40:**
The King will reply, Truly I tell you, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me.
- **Luke 12:48:**
But the one who does not know and does things deserving punishment will be beaten with few blows. From everyone who has been given much, much will be demanded; and from the one who has been entrusted with much, much more will be asked.

WHY CHILD SPONSORSHIP?

- Children are the world's most vulnerable
- When you sponsor a child, you not only walk with that child, but with their entire community

- Initiatives that are designed to benefit children drive the development of an entire community
