OPERATIVE REPORT

Pre-Operative Diagnosis: Right foot, 1st digit hammertoe deformity

Post -Operative Diagnosis: Right foot, 1st digit hammertoe deformity

Procedure: Arthroplasty, right 1st digit

Anesthesia: 3 ml of a 1:1 mixture of 0.5% marcaine plain and 2% lidocaine plain

Surgeon: Constance Ornelas, DPM

The patient was brought into the office OR and seated comfortably in the OR chair. The affected digits were blocked with the above listed local anesthesia. A standard aseptic prep and drape was performed. The procedures were then performed as follows:

Procedure#1: Arthroplasty, right 1st digit

Attention was directed to the dorsolateral aspect of the right 1st digit at which time a 2.0 cm semi-elliptical incision was placed over the PIPJ. The incision site was carefully deepened to the level of long extensor tendon at which time a transverse tenotomy of the tendon was performed. The head of the proximal phalanx was identified and freed of soft tissue attachments. Using double action bone forceps, the head of the phalanx was resected in toto at the surgical neck. The remaining stump was examined and remodeled to a smooth shape. The operative site was copiously flushed with bacteriostatic water. The long extensor tendon was repaired with 4-0 vicryl. Skin was repaired with 5-0 nylon, horizontal mattress sutures. Silvadine gauze dressing applied.
Procedure number one was completed in toto.

The patient tolerated the procedures well and left the office with digital perfusion intact.
