Operative Report

Surgeon: Victoria M. Foley, DPM

Pre-Operative Diagnosis: Soft Tissue Mass 1st digit left foot

Post -Operative Diagnosis: Ganglion

Procedure: Incision and drainage of Ganglion Cyst

Anesthesia: Local block consisting of 3 ml of 1:1 mixture of 1% Xylocaine plain with 0.5% Marcaine plain

Hemostasis: Penrose drain around a 2x2 padded digit

Estimated Blood Loss: Less than 1 ml

Procedure: The patient was brought into the O.R. and placed on the operating table in the supine position. Local anesthesia was induced in the above listed fashion. The surgical site was then prepped and draped in the usual aseptic fashion. Hemostasis was achieved with a penrose drain around a 2 x 2 padded digit.

Procedure # 1: Aspiration of Ganglion Cyst

Attention was directed to the 1st digit left foot. A 0.5 cm stab incision was made and deepened to the subcutaneous area. Utilizing an 18-gauge needle and 3 ml syringe, 0.25 ml of viscous clear fluid was drained from the wound. The wound was then compressed to express more fluid. The wound was flushed with copious amounts of sterile saline. A dressing was applied consisting of antibiotic ointment, gauze and Coban.

The patient tolerated the procedure and anesthesia well and left the office in stable condition and without complication. The 1st left digit was of normal coloration upon discharge.

The patient was given a follow up appointment for one week.
