Operative Report

Pre-Operative Diagnosis: Removal of Wart

Post-Operative Diagnosis: Same as above

Procedure: Removal of verruca with biopsy, left foot

Anesthesia: Local infiltration, using 1.5cc 1% Xylocaine plain with 1.5cc 1/2 % Marcaine plain

Surgeon: Victoria M. Foley, DPM

The left foot was anesthetized with the above listed solution. The left lower extremity was prepped and draped in the usual aseptic fashion and the procedure was performed as follows:

A 2 cm linear incision were placed over lesion. The incision was carefully deepened utilizing both sharp and blunt dissection. The verruca was isolated and removed from the operative site. The area was flushed with copious amounts of sterile saline. Dressings consisted of bacitracin dressing, kling and coban in a moderately compressive dressing. The specimen was sent to pathology.

Patient tolerated the anesthesia and procedures well and left the office in stable condition.

Patient was given post-operative instructions and was given a follow-up appointment for one week.
