

10 Tactics

to Find Unauthorized Sellers

1. Index seller name to your past investigations.
2. Search all aspects of the Amazon Sellers Storefront Pages for any contact information:
 - a. Feedback - Returns & Refunds - Shipping - Policies – Products
3. Search [Google](#) for the seller store name – Try to associate an amazon seller with an ebay Domain Name or other marketplace seller account. [Search here](#)
4. Search [Facebook](#) for the seller store name – Reverse this if you do identify a DBA business or contact name, phone number or email address.
 - a. Facebook search works with email address and phone numbers
5. Search [LinkedIn](#) for the seller business/store name.
 - a. Reverse the above search if a contact name, business entity, phone number, physical address or email address is found.
6. Reverse search [WhitePages](#) for the above identified name, address or phone number.
7. If a domain name is identified use [DomainTools](#) to search the WhoIs information.
 - a. Any information obtained from the WhoIs results should be reverse searched within WhitePages.com
 - b. At times you can take an Amazon seller name and add a .com and search that domain name.
8. Check the state business registration site for known state – State Search Page
9. Place a phone call to any identified phone numbers to obtain information.
10. Last, conduct a product buy – Amazon Non-FBA product unless verifying product quality.
