GENERAL INFORMATION

Students are able to apply for housing by going to www.hocking.edu/residence-halls & selecting the button to apply for housing.

- Applicants **must** have already completed an application to the College in order to apply for housing.

The applicant is able to select the term for which they're applying.

- There is **NO Autumn Semester only** option. The housing contract is for the duration of one academic year or your certificate program.

Applicants are able to select their preferred housing.

ROOMMATES

Applicants are able to list preferred roommates on their application. The application process includes a roommate matching questionnaire. It is very important that the student complete the questionnaire and **not** the parent.

- Students who've already provided us with their preferred roommate information still need to submit this questionnaire in the event that their preferred match decides not to attend.

ROOM ASSIGNMENT

Room assignments will be made on a first-come, first-serve basis upon receipt of the housing application and security deposit. Notification will be sent to the student's Hocking College email address within one week of receipt of the housing application fee and security deposit.

PAYMENT

To reserve a room, submit a dorm application with the \$60 non-refundable application fee.

- A \$250 security deposit is due prior to room assignment.
- The security deposit is non-refundable if a dorm cancellation occurs less than 30 days before the start of classes, if damage is reported in the dorm or if the room is missing items upon checkout.
- If your first option is not available, your balance will be adjusted up or down to reflect the actual room.
- If payment is made with a credit card a \$5 processing fee will be applied.

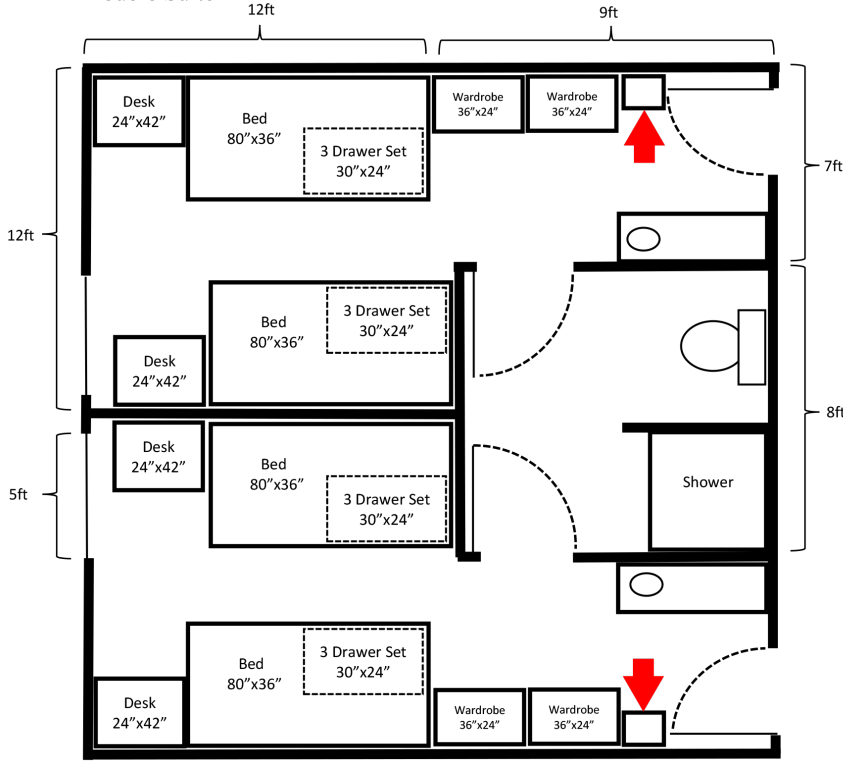

The listed prices **do not** include the required meal plan. Dorm locations can be found on the campus map in your packet.

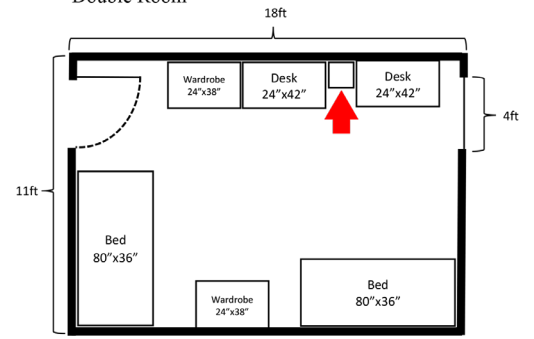

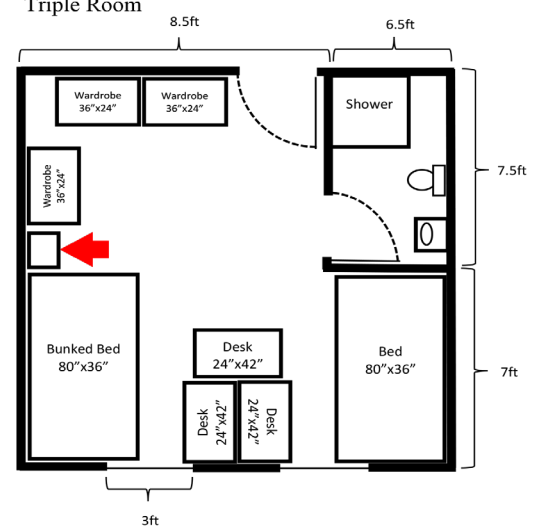


Hocking Heights
Double Room

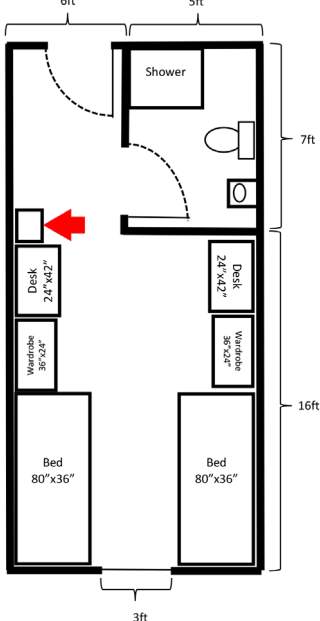
Single — \$2,730
Double — \$2,335



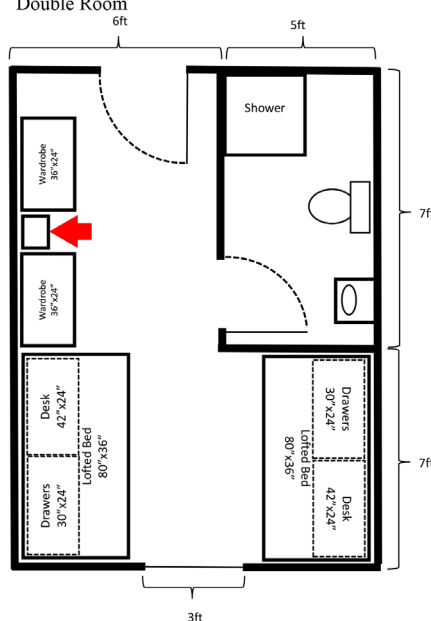
Summit on the River — \$1,975
Triple Room



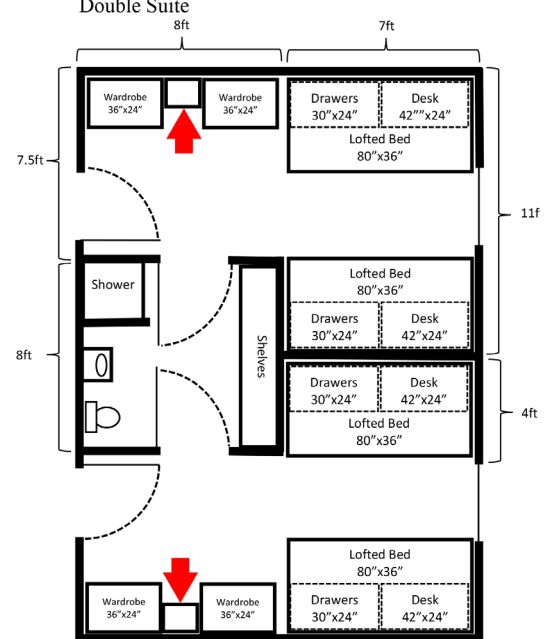
Sycamore Hall — \$2,800
