Massage Therapy Degree Program

The Hocking College Massage Therapy Degree Program consists of four consecutive semesters beginning in Autumn semester and ending 16 months later at the end of the second Autumn semester. This comprehensive Associate Degree program meets all of the requirements necessary for graduates to become licensed by the State Medical Board of Ohio after passing a qualifying exam. While every state approved massage therapy program in Ohio conforms to a basic set of educational guidelines as determined by the state medical board, these guidelines allow a great deal of room for individuality within each program.



Upon completion of this well-rounded program you will possess a solid foundation in the understanding of human anatomy and physiology, demonstrate general office and medical record keeping skills, utilize functional assessments of the musculoskeletal system, and perform a wide variety of manual therapy techniques. You will be able to apply these skills to treat a broad array of musculoskeletal conditions as well as for enhancing circulation, pain management, stress reduction, and maintenance of general health and wellbeing.

ACCREDITATION

Hocking College is fully accredited by the Higher Learning Commission. Additionally, the Hocking College Massage Therapy degree and certificate programs are approved by the State Medical Board of Ohio, thus successful graduates who pass the licensing exam are eligible to practice as a licensed massage therapist in the state of Ohio.

PLACES OF EMPLOYMENT

Some graduates of the program are self-employed independent practitioners in their own professional offices while others work in medical or chiropractic offices, clinics, hospitals, spas, resorts, corporate and factory worksites, or athletic teams. The ever-growing awareness of the health benefits derived from massage therapy continues to create new venues of employment opportunities for well-trained and resourceful therapists.
