PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Medical Assistant Program

Students will learn both the administrative and clinical skills to work in a medical office or clinic. Students will have a hands-on skills lab where they'll practice those skills under the supervision of our instructors.

In year two, students will have two practicum experiences where they go to an area physician's office and perform those skills in a real-world environment. After graduation, students are eligible to sit for the Certified Medical Assistant (CMA) American Association of Medical Assistants (AAMA) exam. Students who successfully complete Phlebotomy and EKG training are eligible to sit for the CPT (NHA) Phlebotomy Certification Exam and the CET (NHA) Certified EKG Technician Exam.



ACCREDITATION



The Medical Assistant Program is accredited by the Commission on Accreditation of Allied Health Education Programs (CAAHEP).
