Physical Therapist Assistant Program

Physical therapist assistants are healthcare providers who work under the supervision of a licensed physical therapist to restore function when disease or injury results in pain and limited movement. Physical therapy intervention can also prevent further injury. When a patient seeks physical therapy services, the physical therapist performs an initial evaluation and develops a plan of care. The physical therapist assistant carries out the plan of care and reports the patient's response to the supervising physical therapist.
