PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Registered Nursing Program

Hocking College's Registered Nursing (RN) Program offers four-semester clinical/theory training which prepares students to take the National Council of Licensure Examination for Registered Nurses (NCLEX-RN). Enriched clinical experiences for the nursing program are obtained in hospitals, long-term care facilities, and clinics within a 75-mile to 100-mile radius of the college. Practical hands-on skills are developed in the medium and high fidelity simulation labs.

RNCareers ranked Hocking College's RN Program #9 in the state of Ohio and as one of the best nursing schools in the nation with a grade of 88.95%. These rankings are based off of a number of factors important to nursing students, including first-time NCLEX passing rates, accreditation, program offerings, tuition costs, faculty strength, and other information important to nurses.



PROGRAM PRE-REQUISITES

Students are required to complete pre-clinical requirements, such as a background check, drug screen, physical examination, STNA Certification, & CPR for the professional rescuer. Students must complete pre-clinical curriculum prior to beginning clinical placement. In addition, students need to pass the HESI A2 exam with 75% or higher in all four test areas.

ACCREDITATION



The Registered Nursing Program is accredited by the Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing (ACEN) and is approved by the Ohio Board of Nursing (OBN).
