

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

STNA Program

The STNA course is rigorous and will give the nurse aide trainee the necessary knowledge and skills to provide basic nursing care to persons who need assistance with their ability to perform activities of daily living or other tasks in a variety of settings. Clinical experience for the STNA course is scheduled at a Center for Medicare & Medicaid Services certified long-term care facility within a 75-mile radius of the college. Nurse aide trainees are responsible for their own transportation to and from the clinical site.

Attendance at all classes, laboratory sessions, and clinical experiences is mandatory per state laws.

Upon successful completion of the program:

- · Students will receive a certificate of completion
- Register for the State STNA Test
- After successful completion of the State STNA test, the trainee will be placed in a State Registry which allows employment as an STNA.

PROGRAM PRE-REQUISITES

Students are required to complete pre-clinical requirements including a background check, drug screen, physical examination. Also required is CPR for the professional rescuer prior to beginning clinical/theory coursework and immunizations including:

- All immunizations must be up-to-date. This includes Seasonal Influenza; COVID-19; Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR) x2 doses or positive titer; Chickenpox (Varicella) x2 doses or positive titer; TDAP (tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis) X1 or up to date TDAP (given every 10 years); Hepatitis B vaccine series or sign form to decline vaccine.
- 2-step Tuberculin (TB) skin test/TST or Mantoux/purified protein derivative (PPD) or evidence of annual testing if already working in a healthcare setting to confirm compliance with this requirement
- Provide current BLS for the Professional Rescuer certification.
 We accept BLS from The American Heart Association, Red
 Cross Course, Health Care Provider, and The American Safety
 & Health Institute.
