Equine Health & Complementary Therapies Program

The Equine Health and Complementary Therapies Program focuses on the health care component of the horse industry. The program was developed to meet the industry demand for qualified horse care technicians.

Students will develop skills in traditional health care such as nutrition, anatomy and physiology, broodmare and foal care, and non-traditional complementary therapies. In addition to traditional health care, Hocking's program includes the newer disciplines of equine acupressure and massage.

This unique component teaches students proper massage techniques for applying pressure to and kneading muscles that are prone to fatigue and stress. Courses such as equine business management and equine marketing will provide students with a solid business background.
