PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Firefighter Certificate Program

Through the fire science program's Firefighter Certificate course students can be prepared to earn both their Firefighter I and Firefighter II certifications in just one semester. All fire science courses at Hocking College follow standards established by the National Fire Protection Association 1001 and the Ohio Department of Public Safety for the education of firefighters.



With our state-of-the-art firefighting equipment and experienced, certified instructors, our students apply direct, hands-on firefighting in our NFPA 1403 compliant burn building, each student develops decision-making skills in simulated emergencies. They also learn CPR and first aid and how to operate our fire trucks. Students who successfully complete the certificate program are ready to enter the fire service as a full- or part-time career or to lend aid to their community as a volunteer for local fire departments and districts.

PLACES OF EMPLOYMENT

The average salary for a Firefighter is 50,850. In Central Ohio, the average salary ranges from \$55,000 - \$100,000.
