Have worked a minimum of 500 hours in perioperative nursing between
January 1, 2014 – December 31, 2018

2 Validate Continued Competency

Choose from one of these methods:

- a) Contact Hours earn 125 CE between January 1, 2014 December 31, 2018
- b) Points accrue 300 points between January 1, 2014 December 31, 2018
- c) Exam pass the CNOR exam by December 31, 2019

 Active CNOR certificants who did not complete their CE or points activities by December 31, 2018 may choose to apply for a CNOR Extension Year. This allows the nurse to use points and CE earned between January 1, 2014 – December 31, 2019 to meet recertification requirements and apply for recertification in 2020 (learn more at www.cc-institute.org/cnor/extension-year). An application for CNOR Extension Year is required by December 31, 2019.
 □ Transferring out of the OR, retiring, or ineligible to recertify?
 Perioperative nurses may choose to preserve their CNOR credential by applying for Emeritus Status. The CNOR(E) credential recognizes the nurse's service and

commitment to the perioperative profession (learn more at www.cc-
