

VOTER REGISTRATION INFORMATION

If you are a citizen of the United States, you have the privilege to vote on your county, state and national leaders. As a part of the Higher Education Act of 1998, Congress directed schools receiving Federal financial aid to assist students who have not yet registered to vote.

To register to vote as a Texas resident, you may visit a local post office to obtain the required Voter Registration form and necessary requirements, or you may also obtain a Voter Registration form at the Secretary of State's web site www.sos.state.tx.us. Once completed you should mail it to your respective county auditor office. The addresses for all county auditors in TX are also found on this site.

If your home state is other than Texas you may use the national form available at the U.S. Election Assistance Commission at http://www.eac.gov/voter_resources/register_to_vote.aspx.

To be eligible to vote in an election the Voter Registration form is to be received at least 15 days before the election (may vary by State, check instructions included in the form).
