## WHAT'S NEW IN SAGE 100

## Version 2018.4 Now Available for Download

Sage 100 2018.4 is now available. Let's take a look at some of the most recent enhancements and product updates that are included in the newest release.

## **Consolidate Multiple Orders in Shipping**

With Sage 100 2018.4, you can now consolidate multiple sales orders into one shipment in Shipping Data Entry. Two new fields have been added on the Entry tab in Shipping Setup Options including **Consolidate Orders on One Invoice** and **Consolidate by Customer PO No**. Depending on the settings you choose, you can consolidate sales orders for one invoice as the orders are processed in Shipping Data Entry and/or consolidate orders into one invoice only if the PO number is the same. You can also consolidate orders into one invoice if the PO numbers are different.

**Shipping Data Entry** - When multiple orders have been added to the current shipment, you can select the Show Detail for All Orders check box to view the lines for all of the orders. If the check box is cleared, the grid displays lines only for the order entered in the Order No. field.

**View Multiple SO and PO Numbers -** When you're viewing an invoice to which multiple sales orders are applied, you can click the Zoom button next to the Order No. field to view a list of the orders. If there are multiple customer purchase order numbers associated with the orders, a Zoom button also appears next to the Customer PO field.

## **Credit Card Processing**

Processing payment cards with EMV chips through <a href="Paya">Paya</a> (formerly Sage Payment Solutions) is now supported when using either <a href="Ingenico">Ingenico</a> ipp320 or <a href="Equinox L5300">Equinox L5300</a> card readers. However, before processing payments with chip cards, you must update your settings in Sage Exchange Desktop:

- 1. In the Windows system tray, right click the Sage Exchange 2.0 icon and then click Settings.
- 2. In the Sage Exchange Settings window, under Hardware, select EMV Devices.
- 3. Select your card reader device.
- 4. Select the Generate EMV receipts check box.

## **Quick Links to Sage University**

A Sage University button has been added to several task windows in AP, AR, Bank Reconciliation, General Ledger, Payroll, and more. You can click the button to view a list of training videos related to the task. Depending on your Business Care plan, there may be no charge to watch the videos.

# What's New in the Latest Release

Sage CRM 2018 Release 3 (R3) is now available. Here's a look at some of the top new features in the latest version including enhancements to the calendar, quick find, MailChimp integration, and more.

#### **Calendar Enhancements**

You can now use the "quick method" to create appointments in My CRM calendar of **other users**. Both you and the other user to whom the calendar belongs are added to the User field of the appointment you create as follows:

- 1. Click My CRM > Calendar
- 2. Open a calendar view (Day, Work Week, or Week)
- Open the calendar of the user for whom you want to create an appointment. In the **Find** text box in the top left corner, type the name of the user. Select the user from the **My CRM for** list, and then click the right-facing arrow.
- 4. Double click anywhere in the calendar grid to create an appointment.

In addition, you can now view calendar items as a list which helps use screen space more efficiently. In the new list view, you can sort, filter, edit, or delete items in the list.

## **Improvements to Quick Find**

In Sage CRM 2018 R3, Quick Find has been improved to search for Person and Company records by their postal address, email address, and phone number.

The most relevant Person and Company records matching all of your search terms (postal, email, or phone) are displayed at the top of the results, followed by the records containing only some of your search criteria.



## **MailChimp Integration**

It seems that each new release builds on the MailChimp integration that was originally introduced several versions ago. The latest integration enhancement allows you to set a new **Closed** status for MailChimp campaigns in Sage CRM which is convenient when you have a long list of campaigns you've run and want to clean things up so it's easier to find and manage current, active campaigns.

#### **Sage Inventory Advisor Basic**

Connects to your Sage 100cloud data to help you reduce forecasting time, optimize inventory levels, streamline purchasing, and achieve optimal fill rates.

#### **Sage 100 cloud Manufacturing**

A suite of advanced manufacturing functionality designed to manage the complexity of discrete manufacturing processes including make-to-stock and build-to-order jobs.



#### **Sage Budgeting and Planning**

A powerful cloud-based financial tool that enables quicker, more informed business decisions by automating and shortening your budgeting and planning cycles.

#### **AP Automation**

An end-to-end integrated solution to automate processing, approval, and payment of accounts payable invoices.

#### **Multi-Bin Warehousing**

Extends the core warehousing capabilities to include the designation, storage, and distribution of a single inventory item in multiple "bin" locations within a warehouse.

#### Sage eCommerce
