- ESL and Citizenship classes for adults (countywide)
- Additional ESL services for children during the summer months (for students in the School District of Lancaster)
- Welcoming Schools Program and Cultural Navigation Services (for all students and their families in the School District of Lancaster who are refugees, immigrants, and English Language Learners)
- School Based Health Care Services (for all students and their families in the School District of Lancaster)
- **Parent Workshops** for families of Reynolds Middle School Students on mindfulness, yoga, and mental health (Workshops are offered twice a month.)
- Extended Day Programming (for Reynolds Middle School students only)
- Power Packs Program (for low income Reynolds Middle School students to help their families provide nutritious meals on the weekends when the school breakfast and lunch programs are unavailable)
- **Uniform Bank** (for all Reynolds Middle School students)
- **Refugee and Immigrant Education Project** (our newest community outreach initiative)
