## CERTIFIED NURSING ASSISTANT

Learn how to provide high quality patient care in a long-term care facility and private home setting. CNA's perform a wide range of basic nursing, personal care and restorative care skills in a classroom and real world setting. Work with various healthcare team members in providing direct patient care. This is a short-term class: 16 days/120 hours program.

## DENTAL ASSISTANT

Learn to perform a variety of duties including taking x-rays, mixing materials, passing instruments, sterilization and receptionist duties, etc. Work alongside other dental professionals to ensure a high-quality of care is delivered to the patient. This full-time program is scheduled from late August to early June and is held during the day.

## EXPANDED FUNCTION DENTAL ASSISTANT

Learning occurs in the classroom, laboratory and pre-clinical settings. The training will culminate in a clinical externship where skills taught in the laboratory and preclinical settings will be performed under the direct supervision of and evaluated by a licensed and practicing dentist. Place bases and liners, amalgam and composite restorations; place and remove matrices, wedges, and rubber dams; coronal polish, apply fluoride. This part-time program is 30-50 weeks/210 hours.

## MEDICAL ASSISTANT

The clinical side of medical assisting involves direct patient care in tasks such as recording vital signs, blood draws, assisting with minor surgical procedures, compiling patients' medical histories and administering medications under the direction of a doctor. In the administrative realm, medical assistants can be responsible for everything from scheduling appointments to billing and assisting patients in filling out insurance forms. This full time program is scheduled from late August to early June and is held during the day OR evenings from January through December.

**LOCATION:** Willow Street Campus

## MEDICAL CODING

This program provides a strong foundation in medical reimbursement and coding. The skills acquired include scheduling patients, preparing patient records, managing financial matters, handling insurance arrangements and processing correspondence. Students are trained to assist doctors and patients administratively in physicians' offices, clinics, hospitals, laboratories or other health service areas. This full-time program is held in the evenings/10 months.

## MEDICAL TERMINOLOGY

Master the language of medicine by learning the word-parts that make up medical terms. Learn terms related to each body system and abbreviations used in medical language. This is a short-term class: 15 weeks/90 hours program.

## PHLEBOTOMY

Students learn necessary safety precautions, terminology, anatomy, physiology, venipuncture, collection procedures and infection control. Prerequisite: Medical Terminology. This is a short-term class: 15 weeks/90 hours program.

## PRACTICAL NURSING

Our program prepares students to serve under the supervision of a registered nurse or a physician in a range of healthcare settings from hospitals to extended care facilities and home health agencies, surgical centers, rehab facilities and doctor offices. Guaranteed clinical experience, lectures, classroom education, and training impart the student with a solid academic foundation. This rigorous course of study enrolls five times a year, and is offered as a full-time day program/12 months and a part-time evening program/18 months.

## VETERINARY TECHNOLOGY

Graduates of this 21-month program will be prepared to provide a wide range of clinical skills including animal patient care, laboratory procedures, medical imaging, anesthesia administration and monitoring and surgical assistance for a variety of domestic animals. Graduate with an Associate in Specialized Technology degree.
