

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Vepica Grupo Internacional's first annual report comes not only after our 43rd Anniversary, but also at a crucial point in the group's history where our vision, our objectives, and our plans, have built momentum and we now have a group powerful enough to guide us to those big changes ahead.

Change only happens when people believe in a dream, when they can understand the vision clearly. Well, our group has continued to show sustainable and profitable growth in 2014, thanks to the conviction of our employees to that dream: becoming one of the top International Contractors.

2014 was a strategically great year for Vepica, where we set the ground for growth: we continued to expand in the international EPC market while achieving progress in our sector diversification strategy.

The group maintains its focus on achieving the goal of working in four clearly defined segments: Oil & Gas, Power Generation, Infrastructure, and Alternative Energies. On this path, we were awarded several important projects for the group.

LOCAL MANAGEMENT, GLOBAL NETWORK

Excelsior, Vepica's subsidiary in Canada, was awarded the engineering and technical assistance for a fertilizer plant located in Alberta. Our USA office, through a 25% participation in a partnership, was awarded a contract to provide EPC services to a Gas Sweetening Plant located in Chiapas, Mexico.

We also had our first international alternative energies contract: a solar generation farm located in Honduras where our client asked us to provide management and supervision. This marks Vepica's first experience of many to come in the international green energy markets.

The group, as a 50% partner of a consortium, was also awarded the EPC and O&M for three 90MW power generation facilities for a major pipeline company in Colombia. This project also marks a first for Vepica, as we enter the EPC market in Colombia, one that shows a profitable future.

In Venezuela, since 2103 we have been working on a very important EPC contract for the development of a Gas Compression Facility in El Furrial, Monagas. Vepica was also awarded an EPC Contract, in partnership with international manufacturers and contractors, for the modernization of the water treatment plant 'La Mariposa' which provides drinking water to a large portion of Venezuela's capital.

Vepica's strong financial position allows it to continuously invest in global growth; as we like to say, "We bring our clients projects to life", and with each passing year we will be able to provide our integral solutions to clients all over the world. Our strategy 'Local Management, Global Network' focuses exactly on that: establishing a local office for specific projects, but providing global assistance through our virtual offices, an approach we have been working on for a couple of years now.

LEADERS AND TALENT DEVELOPMENT

Achieving Vepica's objectives is a team effort, and in order for a team to perform at its highest level, a company must invest in its people. Vepica has countless talented individuals, who are concerned with client satisfaction and the quality of our services. 

AGGREGATED REVENUES


AGGREGATED REVENUES refer to the statutory revenues plus our share of the revenues in those companies or consortia that do not consolidate directly.

2014 revenues were 15% higher than those of the previous year. Participation in larger projects account for this increase.




EBIT, our profitability indicator, refers to earnings before interests and taxes.

2014 EBIT was noticeable higher than that of 2013, both percentage wise and in absolute numbers. This increase was driven by improved project margins and exchange gains.



INSPECTION AND O&M

With over 35 years of experience, Vepica's Inspection Unit specializes in Assurance and Quality Control, Nondestructive Testing (NDT), Asset Management and Commissioning, and Start-up Services.

Our services in Operations and Maintenance include optimization studies and technical support in operations, as well as System Reliability Analysis. Our unit's capacity is close to the 400 thousand man hours a year, executed by 244 professionals.

Our Environment and Water Unit offers a wide variety of services that range from environmental studies and audits, to environmental engineering services in the areas of air pollution control, water and effluent treatment and handling It also covers everything from Industrial Waste Disposal to the recovery of contaminated areas and agricultural engineering.

REVERSE ENGINEERING AND INTELLIGENT MODELING

In 2014, we acquired an interest in Edoxx Technological Services LLC, a Texas-based company that specializes in the provision of reverse engineering services, the generation of As Built Information of existing facilities by capturing data using laser scanning and 3D Intelligent Modeling.

Edoxx's human and technical resources complement and enhance Vepica's existing capabilities in design and 3D Modelling of conceptual and detailed engineering for Oil and Gas facilities onshore and offshore, industrial and power generation plants, and petrochemical complexes.

GAS COMPRESSION PLANT VENEZUELA

Vepica is currently developing the largest onshore gas compression facility in Venezuela, for Petroleos de Venezuela (PDVSA). It aims to compress 200 MCFPD in its first phase. In the second phase, by adding two compressor units the processing capacity will increase to 400 MCFPD.

Not only does this project produce millions in savings from replacing diesel with gas, but it will also bring great environmental benefits by reducing the use of liquid fuels and decreasing flaring of gas in Venezuela. This gas will be incorporated into the distribution network for injection and recovery of oil wells.

This major project has taken on average the work and effort of 500 people of direct labor, and will be completed in 2015.

During the process we have had rigorous technical discussions and debates, as well as differences in criteria that in the end produce great brainstorming. SWEETENING AND FRACTIONATION PLANTS MEXICO

Vepica was awarded, in consortium with Mexican companies, the engineering, procurement, construction, and commissioning for the refurbishment of both a Sweetening and Stabilizing Plant, and a Fractionation Plant in Mexico for PEMEX Gas and Petrochemical subsidiary (PGPB).

The project includes the refurbishment of both the Sweetening Plant, for the treatment of 19,000 bpd of condensate. It also includes the Hydrocarbon Fractionation Plant that handles 104,000 bpd. It demonstrates the growth of Pemex's petrochemical activities, which are of utmost importance for the region.

"This project represents a major step for our company by enabling us to execute an EPC contract in the Mexican market. The joint effort with our partners and our Client PGPB, has represented invaluable learning, as well as being a reference that is opening up new opportunities with other major companies interested in having an ally like Vepica in the market".

ETHANOL COMPLEX VENEZUELA

Vepica has been working in this megaproject that consists in the construction of eleven Agro-Industrial Complexes, designed to process sugar cane for the production of ethyl alcohol (ethanol), sugar and other of its many derivatives.

Our client, PDVSA Agricola, is developing this project in order to replace the Methyl Tertiary Butyl Ether (MTBE) currently mixed in the gasoline that is sold in the Venezuelan market. By doing so, our client will achieve significant savings, as well as an important reduction of environmental pollution (soil, groundwater, greenhouse gas) caused by MTBE.

"Vepica has positioned itself as the Venezuelan company with greatest participation in the development of this megaproject, as a joint effort with PDVSA Agricola. Both companies are facing the challenge of producing energy and food that is sustainable in an economic, social and environmental way. Experiences like this one, are opening new opportunities and markets for our company in the world of alternative energies and renewable energy technologies".



WATER TREATMENT PLANT VENEZUELA

Vepica in consortium with Spanish companies, is performing the engineering, procurement, and commissioning of Venezuela's third largest water treatment plant. This project aims to rehabilitate and optimize the plant, which handles a flow rate of 4,400 liters per second and provides clean water to Caracas.

The scope of the project includes adapting the plant to function under a centralized automated operation, which involves a technological upgrade of. This revamping will ensure the quality of the water, as well as the sustainability of the plant.

VEPICA'S INTEGRATED LEARNING CENTER

For over 40 years, one of Vepica's main concerns has been the professional development and training of its employees. In 2014 the Talent Development Vice-Presidency invested time and resources into the task of creating our own corporate training center, a huge leap in innovation and development for our people.

Vepica's Integrated Learning Center (CIAV) is the result of a team effort. Our allies on this project were the members of Ateneo Empresarial, who were in charge of generating the different workshops that would be taught in the first edition of the program Senior Level Executives also had an important role in this process by participating in meetings to create and define the objectives, the organizational structure, and the curricular structure of the program.

CIAV also relies on the guidance and support of IESA, the principal management and training school for Graduates in Venezuela, and one of the most important and renowned Institutes in Latin America. The first class is scheduled to begin in early 2015.

The CIAV looks to generate competitiveness and sustainable growth in-company, as well as provide and develop different skills of our employees so that they may continue to offer quality services to our clients. It also gives our people an understanding of the business as a whole by looking at it from an entrepreneur's perspective. Finally, the CIAV will structure and align our employees' career plans with their education so that they may become successful leaders within the organization.

OUR SOCIAL COMMITMENT

Year after year Vepica proves its commitment towards the development of our employees and their families, and the improvement of our environment in a sustainable way by investing in various projects that benefit our communities, our employees, and our environment.

During 2014 Vepica invested some USD 1.8m in social programs and contributions, which represent 15% of our result from operations. About USD 1.4m were contributed to government social funds while the remaining was used to fund our four programs: Syllabus, Olimpia, Galapagos and Huellas.

SYLLABUS aims to promote the academic training of our workers, encouraging innovation and improving the quality of education and infrastructure of our neighboring schools. During 2014, the social investment in this program was US \$16,000.

Vepica awarded a postgraduate scholarship to a member of our Engineering Department. We also supported children at risk of dropping out of school, in a neighboring academy with a population of 1,200 children. The group also funded a new technical training center run by Superatec, an organization dedicated to the technical education of young venezuelan students.

Year after year, we provide sponsorship to university projects, such as Formula SAE, Aerodesign and Supermileage. Finally, this year we held our III in-house Technical Conference.

OLIMPIA seeks to improve the overall health and well-being of our employees and their families by promoting sports, cultural and recreational activities. During 2014, Vepica supported various sporting initiatives such as indoor soccer, swimming, running, table tennis,

softball, and domino. It also supported cultural activities such as choir and theater and organized three boot camps for employees, inviting them and their family members for a half day of exercise and fun.

GALAPAGOS aims to educate Vepica's employees in environmental impact, in order to promote environmentally responsible individuals who are committed to reduce their impact on the environment.

In 2014, our group recycled four tons of waste in the forms of paper, plastic, glass, and alkaline batteries. We also published five reports, addressing important issues such as the environmental impact of food waste and how the avoid it, the advantages and disadvantages of using saver bulbs, and information regarding our composting projects.

During this year we also held our yearly Ecological Holiday Card contests, where our employees' children used their creativity to make Holiday decorations or cards using recycled material, as well as our photography contest that encouraged contestants to find examples of environmental conservation through their lens.

HUELLAS is Vepica's volunteering program. In 2014, the group was reviewed and restructured in order to include environmental and educational activities in their social work. Those efforts can be seen in the recent projects aimed at tree planting and donating technical equipment to low-income schools.

The group at the Caracas office established alliances with several social development organizations that attend different needs in Las Minas, a low income community neighbor to our headquarters.
