Inspiro is a not-for-profit community health service. We provide allied health, nursing, counselling and dental services for the Yarra Ranges community from our Lilydale, and Belgrave clinics and various community venues.

About the role

Join our passionate & skilled team on a part-time basis. We have a permanent three-day a week vacancy for a suitably qualified Diabetes Nurse Educator. Days must include Wed and Fri and a third day of your choice.

To be successful in the role, you must be a credentialled diabetes nurse educator and have either demonstrated knowledge of / or experience working within a social model of health and chronic care framework.

Key responsibilities include:

- Undertake comprehensive assessment of clients presenting with diabetes.
- Deliver education that is culturally appropriate, evidence-based and informed by advanced level of clinical knowledge and problem solving.
- Based on the social model of health, develop care plans with clients that reflect their needs whilst aiming to promote independence and enhanced quality of life.
- Initiate Insulin stabilisation for clients as required in collaboration with the General Practitioner and/or Medical Specialist.
- Provide service to both publicly funded clients and clients under as GP care plan.
- Participate in the weekly IDEAS clinic (with Eastern Health endocrinologists)
- Develop a diabetes clinic in partnership with the Healesville Indigenous Community Services Association and other Inspiro staff.

This role requires:

- Credentialed Diabetes Nurse Educator with current registration with Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency (AHPRA) and Australian Diabetes Educators Association (DEA)
- Eligibility for registration as an MBS service provider
- Demonstrated experience and skill in a wide range of clinical assessment procedures, treatments and activities.
- Demonstrated experience in self-management support.
- Capacity to run education programs
- Current Working with Children Check valid for employment purposes
