Big changes for Inspiro in our 21st year!

his year, Inspiro Community Health Service is celebrating the milestone of 21 years of service to people in the Yarra Ranges region.

Ranges Community Health was established in 1995 after the amalgamation of Mooroolbark and Sherbrooke Community Health Centres. In 2000 the purpose-built centre in Clarke Street, Lilydale was opened and in 2012 Ranges Community Health officially changed its name to Inspiro, in response to community feedback.

In 1995 Ranges Community Health had 6 employees and today Inspiro employs more than 85 staff. This year we are continuing to develop our services through dental outreach into aged care facilities, new counselling programs, diabetes education and more.



Importantly, in April our Belgrave site will close so that building work can commence on the new Belgrave

health hub. We have worked to find two venues in Tecoma and at Sherbrooke Family and Children's Centre, to continue delivering our services to this region.

As Inspiro prepares to make room for the new Belgrave Hub, Belgrave is closing and we are moving all services to different locations.



Diabetes Education Understanding diabetes course dates for 2016



This course if for people living with type 2 diabetes. It is a four session program

(2hrs per week) about how to manage diabetes with confidence. It includes talks by a diabetes nurse educator, dietitian, podiatrist and physiotherapist. The cost is \$7 per session.

Exercise Physiology Hip Health Knee Knowledge



This is a four session multidisciplinary information and exercise program for people with hip and knee joint

problems to learn more about:

- causes of hip and knee pain
- how to help your condition
- preventing further damage
- appropriate exercises
- where to next?

Children's Speech Pathology

Inspiro offers speech pathology for children below school-age. We can help with:

- Articulation (speech sound problems)
- Stuttering
- Delayed language skills such as reduced vocabulary, short utterances or poor grammar
- Difficulties understanding words and sentences

Inspiro services are offered for children with mild to moderate delays. For children with more severe delays or disabilities there are other more appropriate services available elsewhere.

Children's Occupational Therapists

Child occupational therapists (OT) at Inspiro support children, with their families, to become more independent in everyday activities. A child occupational therapist will help children with their hand skills (holding a pencil, drawing, cutting with scissors, playing with small objects etc), body skills (balancing, jumping, catching a ball, running etc) and self-care skills (dressing, toileting and sleeping etc). They will also support a child's ability to concentrate, pay attention and manage sensory sensitivities.



Inside Inspiro Tours
