
Services available at Tecoma include Podiatry, Physiotherapy, Counselling, Diabetes Education and Dietitian appointments.

Breaking the stereotype

Residents of the Yarra Ranges region are new benefitting from higher quality and more timely health services. Thanks to a range of improvements we are pleased to announce that waitlists on most serviced have been reduced to a minimum, generally less than two weeks.

We are very pleased to be able to provide more clients with easier access to our services. We pride ourselves on delivering quality health care to everyone and this is truly being delivered.

"A common perception about community health is that our services always have a long waiting list. Well that is not the case. Over the past twelve months we have made several organisational changes in order to run our service more efficiently.

"Changes include employing more staff, managing our appointments differently and establishing mechanisms for measuring, reviewing and setting goals. We also have a range of appointments in response to the new way services are funded such as care plans from GP's.

Since we were established in 1995, Inspiro has grown in all areas of business, last year we saw more than 13,459 clients who had a total of more than 29,000 consultations. That is one in every ten people who live in the Yarra Ranges.

In general our waiting lists are now between one and two weeks depending on the urgency and client eligibility. We have a range of appointments to cater for the different types of services and accept referrals from all sources catering for both fee paying and subsidised services. Please call reception to work out the best way we can help you.

Our services include counselling, dietitians, occupational therapy, physiotherapy, podiatry, speech therapy, diabetes education and dental.

Please note: waiting lists do not apply for people who have priority access. These include Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples, Children, Homeless people, pregnant women, refuges and asylum seeks and registered clients of mental health and disability services. Dental service eligibility may have a longer wait time depending on the type of service required; however urgent referrals and priority clients will be seen promptly. There is also a fee paying dental service available

New floor pilates classes starting in June!

Pilates can help improve posture and movement, which can help reduce back pain.

These new weekly Pilates classes are run by a qualified Physiotherapist using floor mats, small balls, and blocks.
To provide expert assistance, classes are limited to 6 participants.

A physio assessment is required before commencing the program which is \$10 per session.

Emily Molyneux, Lilydale - \$3,000 Inspiro Tertiary Health Scholarship



Emily is currently studying a Bachelor of Psychological Science at Deakin University.

After completing this course Emily will achieve her career goal of becoming a clinical psychologist. She has achieved a high distinction average over the last three years. Emily is interested in working with young people who are living with an eating disorder, and in health behaviour change.

Emily has been volunteering in the local community for around 20 years. Last year Emily volunteered with Eating Disorders of Victoria, providing support on the helpline to people living with an eating disorder.

The Inspiro Tertiary Health Scholarship will help Emily complete her studies and reduce the financial burden of studying and raising a young family.

Children's Speech Pathology

Inspiro offers speech pathology for children below school-age. We can help with:

- Articulation (speech sound problems)
- Stuttering
- Delayed language skills such as reduced vocabulary, short utterances or poor grammar
- Difficulties understanding words and sentences

Inspiro services are offered for children with mild to moderate delays. For children with more severe delays or disabilities there are other more appropriate services available elsewhere.



Child occupational therapists (OT) at Inspiro support children, with their families, to become more independent in everyday activities.

A child occupational therapist will help children with their hand skills (holding a pencil, drawing, cutting with scissors, playing with small objects etc), body skills (balancing, jumping, catching a ball, running etc) and self-care skills (dressing, toileting and sleeping etc).

They will also support a child's ability to concentrate, pay attention and manage sensory sensitivities.
