Direct Service Provision

- Provide a general dental service to clients of Inspiro, in line with all policies, procedures, and guidelines for practice
- Provide services within current Dental Practice Board of Victoria's Code of Practice for Dental Therapists / Hygienists.
- Provide professional guidance and support as appropriate for dental auxiliaries, clerical staff, and any volunteers assisting the dental program.
- Ensure the appropriate referral of patients to Dental Officers
- Participate in dental staff meetings and other activities as directed.
- Meet individual targets set and provide feedback to the Dental Unit Manager on issues related to clinic performance.
- Ensure high levels of customer service by undertaking duties in a professional and timely manner when dealing with clients and the public
- Maintain and process patient records in accordance with DHSV Clinical Record Standards and the Health Records Act 2002.
- Provide oral health promotion and information to clients within the clinical setting.
- Adhere to Inspiro Infection Control Guidelines
- Ensure all equipment is well maintained including diagnosis of common faults
- Be committed to ongoing professional development, and to keep up to date with developments and trends within Community Health.
- Provide a "person centred" model of care that focuses on the individual needs and circumstances of the client
