Increase Safety with These Solutions:



OSHA Section 5(a)(1): Seatbelts prevent operator fatalities during a tip over.



OSHA 1926.602(a)(9)(i): Requires that forklifts shall be equipped with a horn.



Reduces back strain and keeps hands inside the operator compartment.



OSHA 1910.178(H)(2): In lighting less than 2 Im PSF, headlights must be installed.



OSHA 1910.178(n)(6): Enable rear view visibility to avoid potential accidents.



First line of defense in case of forklift or warehouse fire.



Strobe lights capture the attention of nearby pedestrians and forklift operators.



LED lights capture the attention of nearby pedestrians and forklift operators.



OSHA 1917.43(e)(1)(ii): Overhead guards shall not obstruct the operator's view.
