ABOUT THE CUSTOMER

The client is a British multinational telecommunications conglomerate operating predominantly in the regions of Asia, Africa, Europe, and Oceania.

Among mobile operator groups globally, the client is ranked 4th in the number of mobile customers in 2018.

CHALLENGES AND AIMS

The organisation was manually managing their risk register, control frameworks, certifications and security projects, aiming to digitise this into a full-cycle risk management process. They had eleven incident, vulnerability, asset and technology solutions already in place, but stakeholders were becoming overwhelmed with data.

In order for Vodafone to achieve their goals of the implementation of an insight and control solution encompassing governance, risk and compliance, they first needed to look at expanding on many methodologies.

OUR SOLUTION

The client adopted the SYNERGi GRC platform as an out-of-the-box management system for visibility of compliance across ISO27001/2, SOX and GDPR. This implementation has allowed them to gain visibility of its technology and information/data assets, allowing stakeholders to validate compliancy.
