## ACCELERATE INNOVATION IN MICHIGAN'S K-12 SYSTEM

- Prevent any action that would hinder the expansion or creation of innovative K-12 models and teaching strategies, supporting additional avenues for passionate people to actualize ideas on strengthening our MI K-12 system.
- Remove barriers that prevent public charter school students from accessing resources and services, especially special education and career and technical education services, that are available to other public school students.

## DRIVE STUDENT SUCCESS WITH MEANINGFUL ACCOUNTABILITY

- Hold fellow state officials accountable for implementing a single, unified statewide accountability system to ensure it's accessible to parents, is transparent, and is fair.

## INCREASE ACCESSIBILITY TO QUALITY K-12 FOR EVERY COMMUNITY

- Work to ensure ALL public students, including those who attend a charter school have equal access to additional funding and programs, including grants, pilot projects, local programs (like promise zones), etc.
- When necessary, differentiate funding in a justifiable fashion based on individual student needs—such as poverty, special needs, or accelerated learning—without regard to existing or legacy cost structures of schools or districts, grade levels, or medium of education delivery.
