



Supervision & Leadership

Course Overview

Effective leadership starts with a thorough understanding of the organization's vision, mission, and strategies. The role of the Supervisor is to then ensure those strategies, goals, and objectives are achieved. Both Leaders and Supervisors must have excellent listening and facilitation skills to get the best performance from themselves, and the rest of the team.

Supervision & Leadership is a 3 day, interactive leadership and management training course designed to give team leaders the additional knowledge, skills, tools, and techniques to feel more confident, motivated, and self-assured. Using case studies, exercises and open discussion, delegates will gain new insights on goal setting, proper use of language, delegating, giving constructive criticism, and how to positively motivate oneself and others.

Whether you are a future, newly promoted, or experienced Supervisor or Manager, this course will test the limits and challenge what you thought you knew about leadership and supervision. Delegates will leave this training with the key skill requirements and necessary tools to handle any situation and improve workforce productivity by reducing employee turnover rates, meeting time, and non-value activities.

Limited class size (15-20 participants) is strictly enforced to enhance individual learning experiences and interaction with the instructor and other participants.
