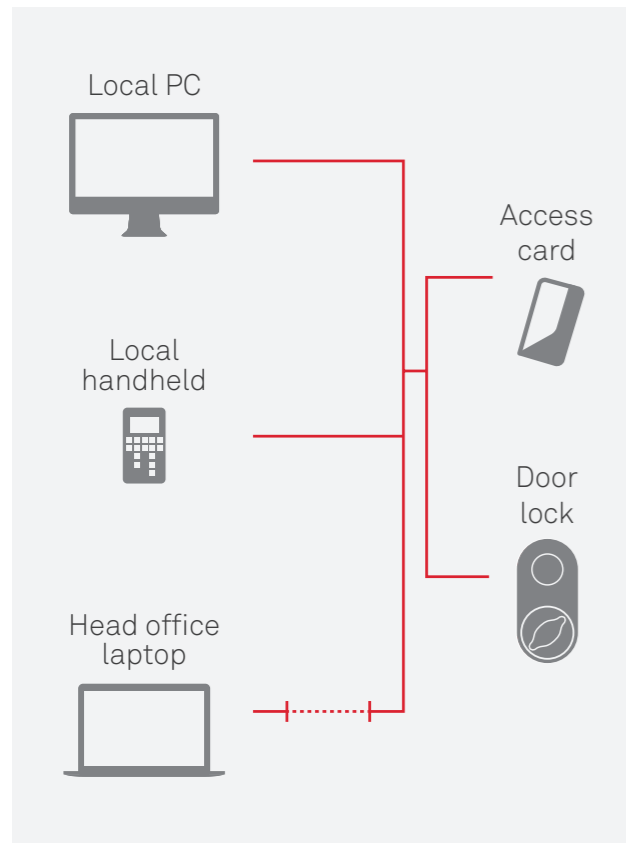

Operated via a wireless network, our smart platform provides secure management of the electronic access control locksets in your ward. It uses minimal cabling, doesn't interfere with existing technology systems, and can also manage existing, compatible electronic locks using our wall readers.



REMOTELY PROGRAMMED

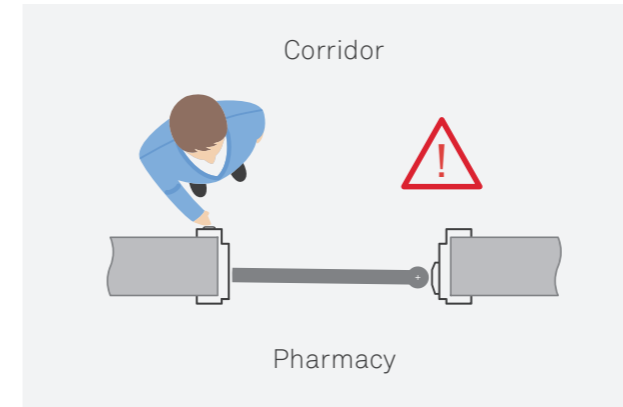
Individual access permissions are programmed remotely at a central ward-based computer or from head office – making it ideal for multi-site organisations. This makes it easier and quicker to manage cards on a large ward and improves security

REAL-TIME UPDATES

Updates are near-instantly applied, providing superior security and allowing staff to respond to changing service user privileges.

Plus the handheld programmer allows permission changes when the wireless network is unavailable, ensuring control of permissions even in extreme circumstances.



REAL-TIME AUDIT TRAIL

Our smart platform records both service user and staff movement, keeping track of any number of cards. It also provides staff time and attendance records – and can even be used to check if service users are isolating themselves or trying to access off-limit areas.

It can be used to highlight attempts to access a restricted room.



WALL READERS

Third party electronic locks are compatible with our smart platform using our vandal resistant wall readers, so there's a system for all electronic locksets throughout a building – simplifying the management of your access control.

REDUCING RESTRICTIVE PRACTISES

Combining safety and speed of access with convenience and service user empowerment, our electronic locksets are built specifically for Mental Health environments.

Instead of mechanical keys, they use access cards, wristbands or key fobs. The wristband can be issued to service users, emulating the home environment by giving them complete control over their living space access – restoring dignity, aiding recovery and reducing restrictive practises in line with Care Quality Commission guidance. Plus it reduces demand on staff to unlock doors.

And it reduces the number of keys carried on the ward, increasing security and eliminating the noise of jangling keys, commonly associated with institutional environments.
