118th regulation: Allow exceptions to weekend and holiday rest related to preventing the spread of COVID-19

118th Ordinance of the Federal Minister of Labor, Family and Youth, which allows exceptions to weekend and holiday rest in connection with the prevention of the spread of COVID-19

On the basis of Section 12 (1) 1 of the Labor Restitution Act, Federal Law Gazette No. 144/1983, as last amended by Federal Law Gazette I No. 22/2019, the following is prescribed:

§ 1. (1) In connection with provisional measures to prevent the spread of COVID-19, employees may use the information contained in the Annex to the Ordinance on Labor Restitution, Federal Law Gazette No. 149/1984, as last amended by Federal Law Gazette II No. 98/2019. Exceptions included during the weekend and holiday rest are engaged in the following activities:

1. Delivery service in the food trade as well as from drugstores and drugstores

- a) Receiving, processing and forwarding orders;
- b) Picking goods;
- c) Handover of the goods to deliverers.

2nd Freight transport

Delivery of goods ordered from the delivery service of the grocery trade as well as from drugstores and drugstores to customers.

§ 2. (1) Work that is directly related to the approved work or without which it would not be possible is permitted, provided that it cannot be carried out before or after the weekend or holiday rest.

(2) The number of employed workers is to be limited to the absolutely necessary extent.

§ 3. Violations of this ordinance will be punished in accordance with Section 27 of the Labor Restitution Act, Federal Law Gazette No. 144/1983.

§ 4. This regulation will expire on May 31, 2020. However, it continues to apply to matters that occurred before the expiry date. ”
