PUBLIC HEALTH (COVID-19) AMENDMENT REGULATIONS 2020

BR 19 / 2020

The Minister responsible for health, in exercise of the power conferred by section 171 of the Public Health Act 1949, makes the following Regulations:

Citation

1 These Regulations may be cited as the Public Health (COVID-19) Amendment Regulations 2020.

Amends regulation 19

2 The Public Health (COVID-19) Regulations 2020 are amended in regulation 19 as follows—

(a) in paragraph (2) by revoking and replacing paragraphs (a) to (d) as follows—

- “(a) comply with the requirements of active monitoring or public health supervision;
- (b) isolate himself from other persons;
- (c) submit to an examination by a medical practitioner or Public Health Officer;
- (d) place himself under the care and treatment of a medical practitioner; or
- (e) conduct himself in such a manner as not to expose another person to infection.”;

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- (b) in paragraph (3) by deleting the words “at the hospital or place of isolation” and substituting the words “at the place of public health supervision, active monitoring or isolation”.
