THE PLANT PROTECTION ACT

(Cap. 324)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 3 (b) and (h) of the Plant Protection Act, the Cabinet Secretary for Agriculture, Livestock, Fisheries and Co-operatives makes the following Rules—

THE PLANT PROTECTION (FEES AND CHARGES)  
(AMENDMENT) RULES, 2020

1. These Rules may be cited as the Plant Protection (Fees and Charges) (Amendment) Rules, 2020 and shall come into operation with effect from the 29th April, 2020.

Citation.

2. The Plant Protection (Fees and Charges) Rules, 2009 (hereafter referred to as the “principal Rules”) are amended in the Schedule, Part B by inserting the expression “excluding tea, coffee, herbs and spices for a period of two (2) years” immediately after the word ‘commodities’ appearing in paragraph 9 (b) (i).

Amendment of Item 9 (b) (i) under Part B of the Schedule of L.N. 48/2009.

3. The principal Rules are amended in the Schedule, Part B by inserting the expression “excluding tea, coffee, herbs and spices for a period of two (2) years” immediately after the word ‘entry’ appearing in paragraph 12 (a) (ii).

Amendment of Item 12 (a) (ii) under Part B of the Schedule of L.N. 48/2009.
