



## Cost Accountant

### Position Summary

This role reports to the CFO and will work closely with the financial controllers of Village companies. You will be reviewing our current processes and reporting for our manufactured finished goods. You will be analyzing the costing of materials and labor with quoted costs to help us understand our mix of products and how that impacts our contribution margins. You will be working with team leaders, value stream coordinators, sales team, purchasing team and finance team to identify and improve our job closings and reporting of margins.

### Responsibilities

- Analyzing actual manufacturing costs including inventory and labor.
- Preparing reports comparing standard costs to actual production costs.
- Analyze finished good reporting and job closings for accurate reporting.
- Work with the controllers in reviewing materials and labor accounts for anomalies and other inconsistencies.
- Assist sales team with reviewing margins and pricing finished goods to customers.
- Review current labor rates and overhead rates.
- Oversee standard costing and PPV reporting and analyze findings for purchased parts and finished goods.
- Work with purchasing and inventory departments to enhance inventory accuracy and improve processes. Oversee cycle counts and month end reporting for inventory.
- Oversee bill of material accuracy.
