Sybase in the Mirror

The whole SAP system landscape of W. Schneider+Co AG has been migrated from Microsoft SQL Server to SAP Sybase ASE

Besides the smooth technical transition, both sides emphasized the direct and quick communication lines that supported a mutual understanding at any point in time.

Starting Point

Both, hardware and operating systems of the SAP system landscape at W. Schneider+Co AG have been getting on in years. While the SAP Releases itself have been upgraded last year, it was time to lift the underlying parts to the most recent level as well.

Due to the difficult negotiations on licensing agreements with Microsoft and SAP, as well as to reduce costs, Schneider was looking for a new database system as well.

Instead of upgrading the already existing Microsoft SQL

Servers 2005 to the more recent version SQL Server 2012, the company opted for a migration to the latest version of the SAP Sybase Adaptive Server Enterprise (ASE).

In a first planning meeting, W. Schneider+Co AG and syslink staff jointly evaluated the opportunities and risks of the relatively new combination of SAP NetWeaver and SAP Sybase ASE.

For the SAP Release upgrades to the latest SAP ECC and SAP Solution Manager versions, the management team of W. Schneider+Co AG already selected syslink as service provider.

Project Path

W. Schneider+Co AG is running a classical 3-system landscape and an SAP Solution Manager under their own responsibility. As there are almost no connecting interfaces to other IT systems, the layout of the migration project was very simple.

“Our customer has provided four new Microsoft Windows Servers 2012 R2 on top of a virtualized Hyper-V infrastructure. We simply migrated the old systems to the new ones by performing a heterogenous system copy. The transition to the new SAP Sybase ASE ran very smoothly” says Remo Zimmermann, Project Manager at syslink.

Within this transition the service provider also installed the latest kernel patches for the SAP systems. After a brief acceptance test phase the systems were

handed over to the customer.

Conclusion

Besides the smooth technical transition, both sides emphasized the direct and quick communication lines that supported a mutual understanding at any point in time. And it was key for finishing this project within a very short period of time.

Now the SAP landscape at W. Schneider+Co AG is in good shape again ensuring continuously reliable SAP system operation during the next couple of years.
