

## CASE STUDY – LONDON SCHOOL OF ECONOMICS



### Project Requirement

Tucked into Portugal Street, just off Lincolns Inn Fields and Kingsway in Holborn, this student building features further world class facilities for the London School of Economics. The design brief included providing shading to shaped windows narrower at the top than bottom, including an electric solution for blackout to a performance space.

### Solution

Labetts installed manual roller blinds with coloured hardware into the glazing slots on standard windows, and Sheer curtains to the shaped curtain walling elements. Finally electric roller blinds to give shading to the atria lightwell above the performance space including one bespoke lifting up shaped blackout blind . These systems give excellent shading with a diffused natural light through the sheer and screen fabric blinds.

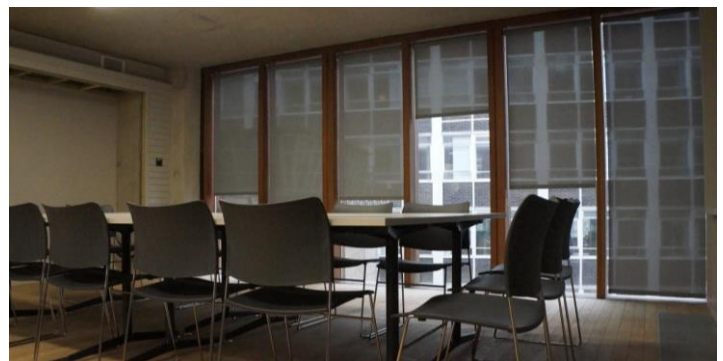
