

Freight Classification Checklist

Want to know how the professionals class your freight? Use this checklist as a guide in order to answer the right questions.

- What is it?**
 - Focus on the one or two words that the manufacturer or shipper uses when they are describing the commodity for sale.
- What does it do?**
 - Give a brief description of the function of the product.
- What is it made of?**
 - State what the primary material is, as well as other materials used in the construction of the commodity.
- How is it packaged?**
 - Is the commodity fully enclosed in a box or crate? Is it shipped loose or on a pallet or skid?
- Is it assembled?**
 - Has the commodity been disassembled, folded, knocked down, etc.?
- Is there a website, digital photos, or documents that show the product?**
 - If possible, please provide a direct link to a webpage, digital images, or associated documents that show the product and how it is used.

Being able to provide your transportation provider with answers to these questions will ensure that your product is classed correctly the first time!
