Steps to buy or lease your new EV through Drive Green with Mass Energy.

- ✓ **Read up on EVs:** start at www.massenergy.org/drivegreen/resources
Make sure to pay attention to range and charging details!
- ✓ **Choose cars you like:** start at www.massenergy.org/drivegreen/cars
- ✓ **Compare prices, dealerships, and deals (lease and buy) for the cars you like with Drive Green's dealers & discounts guide for each car.** Find them at www.massenergy.org/drivegreen/cars
- ✓ **Sign up to test drive on Drive Green with Mass Energy form:** www.massenergy.org/drivegreen/testdrive
- ✓ **Test drive!**
Once you sign up, dealers will contact you to test drive within a couple days. Or, you can reach out to them.

When you buy or lease your car:

- ✓ **Apply for my state rebate**
Apply at: mor-ev.org
Many EVs qualify for the state rebate of up to \$2,500. You must be a MA resident to apply for the MA rebate, but you can buy the vehicle in another state. Can apply to qualifying leases as well as purchases.

- ✓ **Be sure to get a [special "EV" license plate](#) to help promote EVs and to inform public safety personnel.**
