SUMMARY OF DISCUSSION

- Julane Miller-Armbrister reviewed DCHI strategic planning efforts including key findings and emerging strategies. DCHI is sharing the strategic plan with the incoming administration to ensure alignment of efforts and objectives. DCHI is also developing its operational plan for the third grant year.
- Dr. Jasani noted that a Consortium program manager has been hired and will start in January. An offer has also been extended to an Executive Director candidate.
- The Committee reviewed the latest draft of the consensus paper on developing a framework for sustainable workforce capacity assessments. The paper will be introduced to the DCHI Board in January for discussion and potential feedback.

PUBLIC COMMENT

- It was noted that Health Management Associates has been engaged to facilitate the work of the Community Health Worker Subcommittee and will be studying

the role of Community Health Workers and potential funding sources. The results of this work will inform the development of a training program in Delaware.
