SUMMARY OF DISCUSSION

- The Committee received a recap from the August meeting and update from the October Board meeting
- The Committee briefly discussed the status of DCHI initiatives including:
 - The Common Scorecard, which has ~40 practices enrolled since statewide launch in mid-October
 - The Behavioral Health Integration Testing program, which has a tentative launch date of Q1 2017
 - The Transparency Working Group, which is convening to develop recommendations for operationalizing the HCCD
- The Committee co-Chair provided an update on DCHI's strategic planning process including a readout of the 12 emerging strategic priorities, two of which are relevant to the Payment Committee:
 - Adoption of value-based payment broadly
 - Fostering downside risk sharing
- Representatives from Highmark and UnitedHealthcare gave updates on the rollout of their primary care pay for value programs:

- Highmark targeted ~120 practices for commercial value-based payment program (55 have returned contracts) and started recruiting for additional Medicaid True Performance practices this week
- UnitedHealthcare is actively enrolling practices in their Medicaid value-based payment programs and is ~10,000 members short of their 40% goal for 2016 and will focus on moving practices from their BQM to ACO models in 2017
